The City of Tieton developed a Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan in 2017 and identified and prioritized a Pedestrian Corridor and Bicycle Corridor.

- The initial priority for the Pedestrian Corridor was Franklin Road from Vineyard Drive to Naches Avenue.
- The initial priority for the Bicycle Corridor was to connect the City Center to Regional Trails. One leg of improvements would connect the City Center to Summitview Road/Naches-Tieton Road shoulder bicycling route.
